Please let your Den Leader or Michelle Shinn how you can help support The Legionaries and help honor our Veterans this Veterans Day!

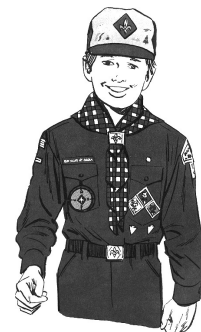
Scouting For Food – November 8th & 15th

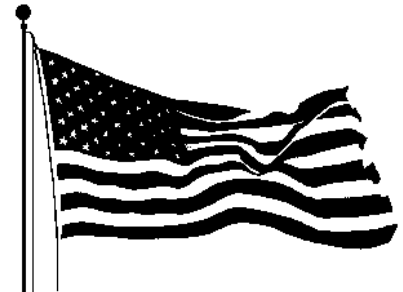
