We are excited to announce the addition of a new Tiger Cub, Tobee, and his brother, Andrew a new Wolf. Welcome to Pack 151!

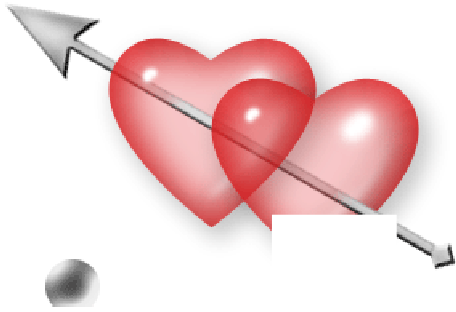
