

Parent Meeting: Sunday, January 11, 2009

Fundraising: There will be a bowling fundraiser at Delta Bowl in Antioch on Monday, January 19, 2009. It is \$9 per person. That will cover the cost of shoes, ball, and bowling for two hours. The time will be 6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. It would be good if the money could be collected beforehand so one check could be paid at time of arrival. A percentage will be donated back to the pack. Friends are invited to come join in the fun. Car washes as a fundraiser in the near future was discussed as well.

Nominations: Kenn Roloff was nominated for Committee Chair and approved by all and he accepted the position. Jeff Tofflemire was nominated for Assistant Bear Den Leader and was approved and accepted the position.

Blue & Gold Banquet: The Blue & Gold Banquet will be held on Saturday, February 28, 2009 from 5:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. There will be ten boys bridging over to boy scouts in a formal ceremony. This is a celebration for all cub scouts. There will be dinner, entertainment, and the ceremony. It was discussed that tri tip, hot dogs, chili cheese dogs, macaroni and potato salad, punch, and dessert would be served. We will also purchase around ten Little Caesar's pizzas for the kids. It will be an "All American" theme. It was discussed that we

might have a DJ for entertainment. We will have a budget to spend. We will need to buy decorations, paper products, etc. We will charge \$5.00 to \$7.00 per person for each ticket, and \$25.00 per family. Family and friends are invited as well.
